ICON Drive Services Vaccine Policy and Procedure:

ICON Drive Services understands that Covid-19 poses an extreme threat to the community, and with that comes a responsibility to keep the community safe. ICON Drive Services follow all government requirements, mandates, and notices, when dealing with Covid-19, including the need to be vaccinated.

All ICON Drive Services personnel are fully vaccinated, as are all contractors used to deliver services for and on behalf of ICON Drive Services. It is our expectation that any person utilizing our services are fully vaccinated as well. This is a requirement that provides a level of protection for the people utilising our services, contractors, business associates, friends, family, and ourselves.

Policy:

For the safety of ICON Drive Services personnel, their contractors, and the wider community, ICON Drive Services will not offer services to a person that is not vaccinated.

ICON Drive Services require any person entering the vehicle for any purpose, to be fully vaccinated prior to the delivery of services offered by ICON Drive Services, or a service requested by ICON Drive Services the requires the use of the vehicle. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Students
- Occupational Therapy Driving Assessors
- Support Workers
- Support Coordinators
- Vic Roads Personnel, including Licence Testing Officers
- Any person(s) working on the vehicle for any reason
- Any person(s) travelling within the vehicle for any reason at any time

In the instance that a person has a valid exemption, can provide proof of the exemption, and has adequately answered the mandatory questions, ICON Drive Services MAY provide service. ICON Drive Services will always look at ways a service can be delivered, however, the decision to provide service is at the discretion of ICON Drive Services alone, and may have requirements applied, such as:

- A wait period is applied
- A negative test result is received, no longer than 3 days prior

ICON Drive Services will not provide services to a person that by choice is not vaccinated, is unwilling to be vaccinated, or has not booked to get vaccinated.

1. Physical distancing

Due to the inability to adequately physically distance while in the vehicle, Instructors will ask the following questions prior to each lesson. If any answer is 'Yes', then the lesson will be cancelled and rescheduled to a later date:	Driving Instructors
	 Are you fully vaccinated, with a government approved vaccine, against Covid-19? If 'No' – Do you have a valid exemption: 'Yes' – To be sighted and all questions answered 'No' 'No' – No service to be offered Do you, or anyone in your family feel unwell, or have any symptoms relating to Covid-19? Have you returned from interstate or overseas in the past 14 days? Have you been required to self-isolate for any reason in the past 30 days? A laminated card will be in the vehicle stating maximum number of persons allowed in the vehicle. When in public places (Test Stations etc), the instructor will abide by social distancing guidelines and any stated requirements. 	
You may need to reduce the number of workers or the number of members of the public at your work premises in accordance with current directions. How will you do this?	Instructors will structure lessons times to allow for sanitisation, screening questions, and general questions. The number of people allowed within the vehicle will be determined by the activity. General Lessons – 2 License Test – 3 OT Assessments - 3 Parents of students will not be allowed in the vehicle, unless for specific medical or exemption reasons.	Driving Instructor

All instructors are trained in the need for physical distancing, the requirement, and application. Training is also provided in the use and disposal of facemasks and any required PPE. 	The instructor will ensure an adequate supply of facemasks is available in the event a student or other persons do not have one. The instructor will provide additional PPE as required to comply with the CovidSafe Plan.

You should reduce the time workers spend in enclosed spaces. How will you do this?	During all lessons, the instructor will request that the student pull to the side of the road, open the windows of the vehicle to allow fresh air to enter. Where possible, a window will be adjusted allowing air flow through the vehicle. When using the air-conditioner or heater, the air flow will be set to take fresh air from outside the vehicle at all times. The recirculation control will not be used, unless driving through freeway tunnels, smoke, or where air quality is compromised. This should only occur until the air quality is deemed acceptable.
